- Interprets project specifications for district construction and materials staff.
- Resolves conflict between contractors and construction personnel when necessary.
- Coordinates district geotechnical needs including preliminary site investigations for future projects.
- Investigates potential quarries for the production of state-approved materials; monitors existing quarries used for

aggregate production.

- Budgets and administers resources for district construction and materials programs; monitors district construction and materials expenditures.
- Supervises district construction and materials staff including making hiring and other employment-related decisions, assigning work, conducting performance management and ensuring appropriate training is provided.
- Performs supervisory responsibilities in a manner consistent with the department's Affirmative Action Program.
- Performs other responsibilities as required or assigned.
