General Summary	The utility locator locates and marks underground cables, pipes and other conduits to prevent damage during excavations. Responsibilities are performed under direct supervision.
Minimum/Required Qualifications	High School Diploma or GED/HiSET Successful completion of a range of motion examination and a medical-physical examination.
Supervisory Responsibilities	None
Location	District Offices - As assigned
Special Working Conditions/Job Characteristics	Job requires moderate physical activity. Job requires exposure to physical hazards, health and safety risks, and/or adverse or otherwise undesirable characteristics in the environment. Job may require operation of vehicles to plow snow and spread ice control materials.

Examples of Work

- (1) Utilizes site plans, area maps and blueprints to locate and mark underground systems which may include high or low voltage electrical cable, fiber optic cable, communication and other utility lines.
- (2) Utilizes conduit-location equipment to perform utility locates.
- (3) Ensures markings and stakes are accurate and visible according to marking standards.
- (4) Communicates to appropriate individuals any potential complications or emergency situations as a result of locate responsibilities.
- (5) Maintains computer database and inventory of utility locations for future reference.
- (6) Transports location equipment and supplies to assigned sites; cleans and maintains location equipment.
- (7) Performs other responsibilities as required or assigned.
