General Summary The traffic studies specialist - nonsafety sensitive provides engineering support to individual units within the Highway Safety and Traffic Division by reviewing and analyzing traffic data to identify concerns and recommend corrective action in order to make improvements in traffic flow, congestion, and safety. Responsibilities are performed under moderate supervision.

Examples of Work

- (1) Reviews and analyzes traffic data to identify concerns and recommend corrective actions.
- (2) Reviews and analyzes real-time and historical traffic data to optimize the performance of existing infrastructure.
- (3) Reviews policies, standards, and other criteria pertaining to signing, pavement marking, signals, lighting, crash records, and permits to make improvements or ensure compliance.
- (4) Reviews policies, standards, and other criteria pertaining to freeway, arterial, access, work zone, and incident management to improve the reliability and safety of roadways.
- (5) Assists in the preparation of transportation related reports, correspondence, and performance measures; may support project development activities as a member of a core team.
- (6) Assists in facilitating and organizing statewide teams for various traffic engineering subject areas.
- (7) Investigates and responds to customer concerns on traffic related issues.
- (8) Performs other responsibilities as required or assigned.
