General Summary	The bridge inspection crew member performs general/visual and in-depth inspection of bridges. Responsibilities are performed under direct supervision.
Minimum/Required Qualifications	High School Diploma or GED/HiSET Valid Class B Commercial Driver's License with no air brake restrictions and interstate status (either Excepted Interstate [EI] or Non-Excepted [NI]). Employee will be required to pass a cardiopulmonary function test yearly, attend training on the use of respirators, and pass a respirator fit test every six months. Successful completion of a work simulation examination and a medical-physical examination.
Supervisory Responsibilities	None
Location	Central Office - Bridge
Special Working Conditions/Job Characteristics	Requires continuous, overnight, statewide travel. Requires significant physical stamina and endurance. Requires exposure to physical hazards, health and safety risks, and/or adverse or otherwise undesirable characteristics in the environment. May require operation of vehicles to plow snow and spread ice control materials.

Examples of Work

- (1) Operates under-bridge inspection and related equipment to visually examine bridges for cracks, fractures, and deterioration.
- (2) Assists in preparing reports and other documentation related to general and in-depth bridge inspection.
- (3) Sets up traffic control devices such as signs, flags, cones, and arrow boards; performs flagging responsibilities for traffic through work zones.
- (4) Conducts equipment safety checks; performs preventative maintenance on vehicles and equipment, including monitoring fluids, greasing and oiling parts, cleaning, and making minor repairs.
- (5) Operates vehicles to transport crew, equipment, and materials to job site.
- (6) May assist routine maintenance crews with snow removal activities, including plowing snow and spreading

ice control materials.

- (7) Performs other responsibilities as required or assigned.
